### Points

- Points awarded per game. Win - 2 points, Draw - 1 point, Loss - 0 points
- Bonus points. 2 points awarded to the team with the higher total shots scored over the 4 games. If the score is equal then each team will be awarded 1 point. The League Secretary will award an aggregate point to the team scoring the higher combined shots over both Home and Away matches and ½ point to each team if there is a draw.

### Important Notes

- Matches will be played to ESMBA Rules in conjunction with the HSMBA Rules and Conditions of Play.
- Games will be played over 12 ends, with the home team changing mats for the second pair of games.
- All players must be ESMBA Registered and may only play for their nominated team unless playing under the terms of HSMBA Rule 2(d) (Cross Substitution). Players representing a team under the provisions of Rule 2(d) must be notified to the opposing captain and recorded on the score sheet *before the match commences*. These players must play only at Lead or Two.
- A team may replace up to 2 players between the first and second pair of games. Replacements, including the name of the player to be replaced, must be notified to the opposing captain and entered on the score sheet *before the match commences*.
- The Captain of the Home Team is responsible for emailing or posting this match sheet, to be received by the League Secretary not later than the fourth morning after the match.**
- Captains should retain all score cards until the end of the season as they may be needed for clarification.
